## Political Action Contributions

Included in your membership total is a \$17 voluntary contribution to ISEA PAC, the Association's political action organization that works to elect pro-education candidates to local and statewide office. By contributing to ISEA PAC, you can make a difference. Together, contributions from ISEA members across the state enable the Association to compete for scarce resources and allow your voice to be heard in the highly volatile political arena.

NEA Fund for Children and Public Education (NEA Fund) collects voluntary contributions from Association members which are used for political purposes, including, but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for federal office. Only U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents may contribute to the NEA Fund. Contributions to the NEA Fund are voluntary; making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount (\$15), or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights, or benefits in NEA or any of its affiliates. Contributions or gifts to the NEA Fund are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. Federal law prohibits the NEA Fund from receiving donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families, will be returned forthwith.

Of course, you're free to give a higher amount, a lower amount, or no amount to ISEA PAC and the NEA Fund, and doing so will not in any way affect your status as a member of the ISEA, NEA, or your Local Association. Members desiring to contribute more or less than \$17 to ISEA PAC should cross through the \$17 and indicate the total amount they wish to contribute in parentheses. Similarly, a member wishing to opt out of making a \$17 contribution to ISEA PAC should cross through the \$17 that has been printed in the asterisked statement in the AMOUNTS section and write \$0 in the parentheses.
