

ISEA Support Courses

The ISEA provides information and support for educators interested in pursuing National Board Certification. The ISEA Academy offers four one-credit hour courses which can be taken for license renewal, graduate credit, or audited.

There are four National Board Components. Since Component 1, Content Knowledge, is demonstrated through an assessment, specific to one of 25 certificate areas, we do not hold a separate class for it. Information is embedded in each of the other component support courses.

Jump Start: Exploring National Board Certification:

The pre-candidate course focuses on foundational information, component overviews, and the opportunity to gather resources and information as work on plan to pursue certification.

NB: Differentiation in Instruction (Component 2):

Focus is on your ability to evaluate learning strengths and needs for individual students, plan and implement appropriate differentiated instruction for those students, and analyze and modify instructional strategies and materials based on ongoing assessment.

NB: Teaching Practice and Learning Environment (Component 3):

Focus is on instructional planning, direct evidence of your practice, student engagement and your analysis of and reflection on your teaching in your learning environment.

NB: Effective and Reflective Practitioner (Component 4):

Focus is on your ability as an effective and reflective practitioner in developing and applying your knowledge of your students, including collaboration with others in a learning community.
