

### School Board Elections

**July 8** – First day a voter can request an Absentee Ballot Request form.

**August 26**- First day a candidate can file for school election office.

- Candidates must file with the school secretary of the school district in which you are running.
- For candidates: Nomination petitions are available at your county auditor's website and/or office. The nomination petitions have changed and now require the person collecting signatures (at least 50 for school board to be safe) to include their name, address and phone number at the bottom of the form to verify who is collecting the signatures.

**September 19** - Final day a candidate can file for school election office.

**October 7** - First day Absentee Ballots are mailed out to voters.

**October 7** - First Day a voter can vote in person at the County Auditor's office.

**October 25** - General Election Voter Pre-Registration & Absentee Ballot Request Deadline.

- Get out the vote efforts for general election.

**November 5 –Election Day** – Polls Open 7 AM – 8PM.

- Please note that the polling location for your school district may change.

### Recertification Elections

- August 26 – PERB files electronic notice of intent to hold an election in locals where applicable.
- September 3 – last day for employers to turn in the initial voter lists to PERB
- September 16 – last day to pay fee to PERB (ISEA pays this and bills locals later).
- October 8 – last day any changes to voter lists can be sent to PERB
- Locals hold recertification outreach including vote parties and voting reminders.
- October 15 (8am)– October 29 (9am) - Recertification election voting is open.
