Introduction

- Lower grades include information on different strategies that parents can used to help the students with the presented skill

Presentations

- Include I Do demonstration lesson to show the skill so parents and students have a guide.
- Include reflective questions and hints to guide thinking
- Include an anchor chart to facilitate learning.

Learning Objects

Include other websites that provide additional information on the presented skill or concepts to extend learning.

Discussion

Include an interactive discussion board to answer questions, generate student response, and assess understanding for learning gaps.

Assignments

Performance tasks that students can do to show their understanding of the presented concept or skill.
