# Introduction

- ▶ Include a hook to engage the student (demo, reflective question, picture, and/or graph)

# Readings

- ▶ In this section, include reading that provide background knowledge about the concept or skill that students can read.
- ▶ Lower grades include information on different strategies that parents can used to help the students with the presented skill

# Presentations

- ▶ Include I Do demonstration lesson to show the skill so parents and students have a guide.
- ▶ Include reflective questions and hints to guide thinking
- ▶ Include an anchor chart to facilitate learning.

# Learning Objects

- ▶ Include other websites that provide additional information on the presented skill or concepts to extend learning.

# Discussion

- ▶ Include an interactive discussion board to answer questions, generate student response, and assess understanding for learning gaps.

# Assignments

- ▶ Performance tasks that students can do to show their understanding of the presented concept or skill.
